An abbreviated version of a Lincoln-Douglas debate runs about 15 minutes, including time for transitions and claims to be made during each stage of the process:
First Pro Speaker:
Two minutes to introduce the topic and defend the resolution
First Con Speaker:
Two minutes to restate the opponent's viewpoint and to challenge the affirmative position
Second Pro Speaker:
Two minutes to disagree with the arguments of the negative position Second Con Speaker:

Two minutes to offer a new challenge to the pro position.

## Break for Rebuttal Speech Preparation: Two minutes to transition

Con Summary/Rebuttal Speaker:
Two minutes to conclude by challenging points made by the affirmative team and by re-arguing the con argument.

Pro Summary/Rebuttal Speaker:
Two minutes to conclude by challenging points made by the con team and by re-arguing the pro argument.
